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The PFM Reform Program featured in the Annual Speech of the President for 2020

The Minister of Finance
Development Signs the Implementation
Circular for IPSAS Cash Basis

he President of the Republic of Somaliland His Excellency Muse Bihi Abdi has Noted the key achievements of the PFM reform Program in his Annual Address to the nation on February 18, 2020.

President Bihi highlighted how the undertaken reforms of the PFM program contribute to improved financial management of the government of Somaliland.

"The PFM interventions improve financial management systems, revenue collection, public service delivery and expenditure control" says president Bihi in his Annual Address.

The broad objective of the public Financial Management is to achieve overall fiscal discipline, allocation of resources to priority needs, efficient and effective allocation of public services delivery.

The PFM strives to achieve the highest possible efficiency, transparency, and accountability in the allocation, management and use of public finances to meet the national Development Plan priorities and stimulate economic growth.

The Minster of Finance Development Dr. Saad Ali Shire has recently signed the official Implementation Circular for IPSAS Cash Basis. IPSAS Stands for International Public Sector Accounting Standards, it is principles-based fair presentation cash basis accounting framework that is developed and maintained by the International Public Sector Accounting Standards Board.

This will improve the quality, accuracy and completeness of financial statements leading to better-informed assessments of the resource allocation decisions made by governments, thereby increasing transparency and accountability.



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The PFM Coordination Department in collaboration with the Accountant General Office has organized a two-day training on Comprehensive Operating Accounting Procedures and Financial Regulations Manuals for 22 (7 female) civil servants from the Office of the Accountant General on February 1st 2020.

The training was designed to familiarize Financial Management practitioners and accountants with the Accounting Procedures and Financial Regulations manuals, as part of the PFM supported capacity building initiatives for achieving anticipated reform objectives.

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163 Civil Servants Trained on SLFMIS Payroll, Contract Management, and E-Voucher Modules.

The PFM Coordination Department in collaboration with the SLFMIS team has organized a Nine-day training on payroll, contract management and e-voucher modules for 163 (66 female) civil servants on February 05 -16, 2020. The participants were drawn from 68 Central Government Ministries, Departments and Agencies (MDAs). The training was intended to equip Admin and Finance, Accountants and Human Resource Officers with the different skills, knowledge, and information on the application of the selected modules.

The Payroll Module controls the payroll payment and will be linked to both the Human Resource Management Information System (HRMIS) and Somaliland Central Bank to ensure that payroll payment process is efficient and effective and to avoid error and delayed payment.

The Contract Management Module controls the Contracts signed by the Government institutions and ensures that payments are directly linked to the achievement of agreed milestones and deliverables. This Module also helps avoid double-payment and payment without performance.

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30 Civil Servants Trained on Compliance Audit

The PFM reform Coordination Department in collaboration with the Office of the Auditor General has organized a two-week long training on Compliance Audit Manual for 30 (5 female) staff from the Auditor General Office on February 10, 2020 The training was officially opened by the Auditor General Mr. Ahmed Yusuf Dirir.

The Compliance Audit Manual facilitates the performance of compliance audits as per the International Standards of Supreme Audit Institutions (ISSAIs) and provides a guidance on how to conduct a compliance audit and explains the main concepts of compliance audit and links it to the audit practice.

The objective of conducting a compliance audit is to assess the overall effectiveness of an auditee compliance practices and protocols. While examining processes and transactions, a compliance auditor determines whether the item being examined complies with established standards

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28 Civil ServantsTrained On IPSAS Cash Basis

The PFM Coordination Department in collaboration the Office of the Auditor General (OAG) has organized a four-day training on International Public Sector Accounting Standards, on February 22nd 2020, at Maansoor Hotel Hargeisa.

The training equips participants with the skills, principles and practices of the International Public Sector Accounting Standards (IPSAS) Cash Basis and enables them to apply in their respective roles within the Government of Somaliland. Participants of the training were drawn from the key public financial management institutions.

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PFM familiarization Seminar Conducted for 23 Director Generals.

The PFM Coordination Department has conducted a one-day PFM familiarization seminar for 23 (1 female) Director Generals of Ministries, Departments and Agencies on February 23, 2020, at Royal Palace Hotel, Hargeisa.

The workshop was aimed to familiarize Directors with their roles and responsibilities in fulfilling the PFM reforms in their respective institutions and to seek and secure their commitments and collaboration to ensure the success of the PFM reforms. In his opening remarks Dr. Saad Ali Shire, the Minister of Finance Development has highlighted the significance of the role of Director Generals in the PFM reform processes, as change agents.

The PFM reform stakeholders have presented key progress and achievements of the various reform components, followed by Question & Answer sessions deliberated by Muse Ibrahim Yusuf, the Deputy Minister of Finance Development, Mohamed Abdi Gurhan, Director General of the Ministry of Finance Development and Ahmed Daud Geeddi, the Accountant General of the State.

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The PFM coordination Department in Collaboration with the Office of the Auditor General (OAG) has conducted a one-ay workshop on Peer-to-peer learning for 30 (8 female) senior officers from key branches of the government, including Executive, legislative and Judiciary, on February 29, 2020.

The peer-to-peer learning is a common trend to share experience and gain information from fellow staff to enhance skill sets and leverage existing knowledge in the workplace.

The primary objective for the event was to establish a platform for sharing tacit knowledge, skills and experience and to challenge the silo mentality in the public sector, and finally to refresh stakeholders about the recent reform progress in the Office of the Auditor General.

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28 Civil Servants Trained on Financial Management and Accounting Procedures

The PFM reform Coordination Department has organized a seven-ay training on External Assistance Fiduciary Manual and Compressive Operating Accounting and Procedures Manual, for 28 (8 female) key staff from the Accountant General Office (AGO) Office of the Auditor General and other Ministries, Departments and Agencies, on March 17 – 24, 2020, using online platform for most the training, following the shutdown resulted by the COVID-19 Pandemic.

The External Assistance Fiduciary Manual, guides Project mplementation Units (PIUs) staff on planning, budgeting, banking, funds disbursement, payments from projects funds, internal controls over funds, reporting and monitoring, procurement and auditing arrangements for the projects funded through the Eexternal Adistance fiduciary Ssection of the Office of the Accountant General.

This training is aimed at setting out a standardized Financial Management system for use in government services, which is capable of producing accurate and reliable accounts free from errors and fraud.
